Terms and Conditions for Artist Participation in the Moore Street Project

Each artist who would like to participate in the Up Your Arts Moore Street Project may submit up to ten entries to be considered for inclusion in the project, subject to the following terms and conditions:

All submissions must be made via email and include high-resolution JPEG (or similar) electronic files of artwork to be considered.

All artwork must be original 2D or 3D works of art completed by the artist making the submission (or the agent thereof). Please note that limited space is available for the display of 3D art.

All 2D art must be ready for hanging via hanging wire or attached mounting clips. Any permanent medium, framed or unframed, will be considered for inclusion. All 3D art must be carefully packaged for delivery and include any required display material.

An Up Your Arts designee will select artwork based on his or her own choice, criteria and display availability. We hope to showcase the work of local artists whose original work reflects the colorful, creative and bold imagining of the greater Southport community. Please allow up to 15 days for post submission review and selection.

Up Your Arts will retain the right to display and install all artwork in a location and manner it deems best. Signage will be located adjacent to each work indicating title, medium, artist name, affiliation and retail price.

Work selected for gallery display will remain installed for a minimum of three months, unless sold, removal is requested by artist or removal is requested by premise owner. Some works may be pre-selected for future gallery display as space becomes available. All work thus selected will also be displayed and offered for sale on the Up Your Arts website. In addition, some works may be selected for display and sale only on the website.

All artwork will be available for purchase by the general public (or via the Up Your Arts website). Up Your Arts will determine the actual retail price of each piece of artwork via the following:

A 25% fee will be added to the price listed in each participant's application. This fee will be in support of the mission of Up Your Arts. The required sales tax will then be added to the total retail cost, and remitted appropriately by Up Your Arts. (Note that premises/business owners will not receive a percentage of sales). If artwork is purchased via electronic website sales the same formula will apply, but an additional shipping and handling charge will be made by Up Your Arts, to be incurred by the purchaser.

All artists agree to allow images and descriptions of their work to be used in promotion and/or advertising specific to gallery and website exhibition. Artists will retain general copyright ownership, and their artwork will not be used without permission except as noted above. Each artist relinquishes any claim to reimbursement for any loss related to theft or damages which may occur during public exhibition of their work.

All selected artists will be invited to participate in various gallery/exhibition events.
